January 1836 have given granted bargained and sold and delivered and by these presents do give  
grant bargain sell and deliver unto Edwards Bettis trustee for Rebecca T Everett & children  
girl by name of Mally and her future increase to him the P E Bettis trustee upon this his said  
That he or his representative shall at the death of the aforesd. Rebecca T Everett or by her the said  
Rebecca T Everett request in her life either, convey a lawful title to the said negro girl and her  
increase to Indiana ell of Everett daughter of the said Rebecca T Everett with the sum  
Rebecca T Everett shall by the death of her present husband be left a widow and should die by  
especiall hereby obligatory by these presents for the trustee to immediately give a title and pay  
of P. negro girl Mally and increase to the P. Indiana ell of Everett her heirs &c as aforesaid  
hand and seal this 21<sup>st</sup> January 1839

order. Now if the said Nathaniel Burnes shall well and truly discharge the duties of the office of con-
