our seals and dated this 21st day of January 1839

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound James D Deapenberg is consti-
tuted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the Governor under the
Seal of the Commonwealth dated the twenty seventh day of December 1838. If therefore the said James
Deapenberg shall well and truly collect and receive all officers fees and dues put into his hands
to collect and duly account for and pay the same to the officers to whom such fees are due respectively
at such times as are prescribed and limited by Law and shall well and truly execute, and due returns
make of all process and precepts to him directed and pay and satisfy all sums of money and to receive by
him received in virtue of any such process to the person or persons to whom the same are due his other
Executors administrators or assigns and in all things shall truly and faithfully execute and perform
The said office of Sheriff during the term of his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void
otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
