I know all men by these presents that we James D. Mapenbury Jarrow burg Turned 33 Years from Beginning of Robert Ricks be held and firmly bound unto David Barnhill Esq; Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of Thirty Thousand dollars to be paid unto the said Governor and his successors for the use of the said Commonwealth for the payment whereof we and truly to be made and bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated the 25th day of January 1839.
 The bondholder of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound James D. Mapenbury is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 25th day of December 1838. By virtue whereof James D. Mapenbury shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the taxes imposed by law and assess of Taxes due in the said County of Southampton and shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the militia fines imposed by law and assess of militia fine due in the said County of Southampton Then the above obligation to be void thereafter when in full force and payment.

This Indenture made and entered into this day of January 1839 between Samuel Pelkernord and Edwin G Hart of the one part Littleton R. Edwards of the second part and Edwin Butts of the third part all of the County of Southampton. Witnesseth that whereas the said Samuel Pelkernord and Edwin G Hart are indebted to the said Edwin Butts in the just and full sum of five hundred and thirty four 448 Dollars by bond bearing date the 25th day of January 1839 and being willing and desirous to secure the payment thereof hath agreed to convey the property herein mentioned unto the said Littleton R. Edwards in trust to be sold for the purpose hereto before the said Samuel Pelkernord & Edwin G Hart as well for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Littleton R. Edwards also for the conveying and delivery of these presents hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents bargained and sold unto the said Littleton R. Edwards his executors or administrators or his assigns the debt above mentioned due him with the legal interest thereon and the same to be null & void but in case they or their executors or administrators shall when required by the said Edwards Butts his executors or assigns fail to pay the said debt and interest due thereon it shall at any time thereafter be lawful for the said Littleton R. Edwards or in case he be dead his personal representative who is hereby authorized to act upon the request of the said Butts to have names or assigns to make sale of the negro girl aforesaid and increase for any sum by giving reasonable public notice thereof and out of the money arising therefrom day and to satisfy the debt aforesaid due the said Butts or so much thereof as shall be in arrears at the time and interest and the cost of expenses attending the said sale and the money arising therefrom if any pay over to the said Hart his executors or assigns.
