Witnesses that whereas this said Samuel Polkenhorn and Edwin Hart are indebted to the said Edwards Butts in the just and full sum of five hundred and thirty four 4/100 Dollars by bond bearing date the 25th day of January 1839 and being willing and desirous to secure the payment thereof hath agreed to convey the property herein after mentioned unto the said Littleton R Edwards in Trust to be sold for that purpose before the said Samuel Polkenhorn & Edwin Hart as well for and in consideration of the sum as of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Littleton R Edwards at the time the sealing and delivery of these presents hath granted bargained and sold unto the said Littleton R Edwards his Exors & adms one negro girl named Aggy now in possession of the said Polkenhorn leasnd or hired hand by the said Hart. To have and to hold the said negro girl slave unto him the said Littleton R Edwards his Exors. Executors forever. Upon Trust nevertheless that if the said Polkenhorn & Hart or either of them or the Exors or admors of either of them shall when required pay the said Butts or assign the debt above mentioned due him with the legal interest thereon then this Indenture to be null & void. but in case they or their Exors or admors shall when required by the said Edwards Butts his Exors admors or assigns fail to pay the said debt and interest due thereon it shall at any time thereafter be lawful for the said Littleton R Edwards for or in case of his legal personal representative who is hereby authorized to act, upon the request of the said Butts his Exors admors or assigns to make sale of the said negro girl aforesaid and increase if any for such long given reasonable public notice thereof and out of the money arising therefrom pay and satisfy the debt aforesaid due the said Butts or so much thereof as shall be in arrear at the time and interest and the cost & expenses attending the said sale and this conveyance and surplus if any pay over to the said Hart his Exors admors or assigns.
