This Indenture made this 7<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord 1839 Between Henry Booth of the first part Lambert Watkins of the second part and John A. Booth of the third part witness the said Henry Booth is justly indebted to the said John A. Booth in the sum of One hundred & eighteen dollars & eighty four cents to be paid on the seventh day of January in the year 1839 as by a bond bearing date on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of January 1839 more fully appears which debt with legal interest according to the said Henry Booth is willing and desires to incur Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the promises and also for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful money in Virginia to the said Henry Booth is here paid by the said Lambert Watkins at and before the sealing and delivery of the present the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Henry Booth hath given & made bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth give & grant bargained sold and confirmed to the said Lambert Watkins his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the county of Southampton containing One hundred and ninety acres including the house whereon the said Henry Booth now resides and bounded by the lands of Lewis Branch Willis Wilton and the said John A. Booth and the lands formerly belonging to Edwin Francis also the following property five feather beds and furniture two tables one clock one Cupboard one flag half dozen Chairs. Cookery one iron and colp. Kitchen furniture one Bart Caisse and feather two Dows and Thirteen sheets with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the estate right title and Interest of the said Henry Booth is to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcel of land and promises to have & to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted tract or parcel of Land and promises with its appurtenances unto the said Lambert Watkins his heirs executors and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Lambert Watkins his executors and assigns forever and the said Henry Booth for himself his heirs executors and assigns hereby covenants promises and agrees to undertake to the said Lambert Watkins his heirs executors and assigns forever in manner and form following To say that the said Henry Booth his heirs executors and assigns the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and promises with its appurtenances together with all the aforesaid property hereby conveyed unto the said Lambert Watkins his heirs executors and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and do and forever defend by these presents Alford trust nevertheless that the said Lambert Watkins his heirs executors and assigns shall permit the said Henry Booth to remain in quiet possession of the said tract or parcel of Land and promises with its appurtenances together with the property hereby conveyed unto the said Lambert Watkins his heirs executors and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and do and forever defend by these presents Alford trust nevertheless that the said Lambert Watkins his heirs executors and assigns shall pay default of such payment advertise at least Twenty day at three public places in the County of Southampton and sell for cash the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and other property out of the proceeds of such sale pay and satisfy all cost attending this tract or parcel of Land and other property and interest that may ~~may~~ arise therefrom the balance if any pay over to the said Henry Booth or such other persons as he may under his hand otherwise to receive the same there this Indenture to be valid or else to remain in full force and virtue as
