This indenture made and entered into this 18th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and one and thirty nine between Stephen H. Washington of the first part Benjamin Griffers of the second part and Patrick Dole of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia; Witnesseth that the said Stephen H. Washington for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars which sum is due from the said Stephen H. Washington to the said Patrick Dole by bond bearing date this 18th day of February one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine as well as all other monies which may be due and owing from the said Stephen H. Washington to the said Patrick Dole by means of any dealings transfer of debt or paper whatsoever as also in and consideration of one dollar to one in hand paid by the said Benjamin Griffers the receipt whereof the said Stephen H. Washington doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargain'd and sold unto the said Benjamin Griffers and his heirs forever all his right and interest in the following property to wit one certain negro man named Aaron of surname Duckay of child belonging to him the said Stephen H. Washington here in conveyance have and to hold with all right and interest of the said Stephen H. Washington here in conveyance or intended to be conveyed to him the said Benjamin Griffers his heirs and assigns forever upon the special trust nevertheless that the said Benjamin Griffers upon being requested by the said Patrick Dole shall proceed to sell all the right and interest of the said Stephen H. Washington to the above named property hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after advertising the same two day at some publick place or places for two day previous at some publick hour or store for cash and out of the money arising out of said the said sale in the first place pay and satisfy all cost attending the said sale as well as the expenses attending the said conveyance and then pay of the bond aforesaid with interest as well as all other monies which may appear to be due and owing from the said Stephen H. Washington to the said Patrick Dole by means of any dealings transfer of debt or paper whatsoever and the surplus if any pay to the said Stephen H. Washington; and the said Stephen H.
