Moody his wife of Greensville County Wm. of the one part and Bird Lundy of the County of Southampton of the other part Witnesseth that the said John all cloudy of Martha W. his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand dollars to them in hand paid by the said Bird Lundy at or before the entering of this presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John all cloudy and Martha W. his wife have bargained sold and delivered by these presents to bargain sell and deliver unto the said Bird Lundy and his heirs forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia containing five hundred and fifty one acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Thomas Williams and Richard Gellam Clamson & Robinson & others to have and to hold the said land & premises to him the said Bird Lundy and his heirs & assigns forever. I the said John all cloudy do for myself my heirs and assigns warrant and defend the right and title of said land and premises against the claims or claims of any person or persons whatsoever unto him the said Bird Lundy his heirs or assigns.
