This Indenture made this 12th day of March 1839 between Joseph Joyner of the one part and Henry Hindrod of the other part both of the County of Southampton and State of N^o Carolina that the said Joseph Joyner for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and confirmed and do by these presents grant bargain sell and conveyed unto the said Henry Hindrod his heirs and assigns forever one certain piece lot or parcel of land being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and it being all my interest or demands of the lands of Gully Coville etc. left to me by Will by the said Gully Coville the boundaries whereof will more fully appear having reference to the report of Commissioners appointed to divide the same and which is of record in the County Court of Southampton. To have and to hold all and singular the said granted land and premises above mentioned unto the said Henry Hindrod his heirs and assigns forever and the said Joseph Joyner for himself heirs &c. doth further and agree to and with the said Henry Hindrod his heirs &c. that they will forever warrant and defend the right title & interest vested in him of the said premises here mentioned unto him the said Henry Hindrod his heirs and assigns forever against the claim and demand of him the said Joseph Joyner his heirs & assigns forever or any other person or persons whatsoever claiming by him or under him.
