This Indenture made this 15th day of March in this year of our Lord 1839 between John Wilson of the first
 part Benj^e Daughtery of the second part and Thomas N Story a citizen of the third part. Where the said John
 Wilson is justly indebted to the said Thomas N Story in the sum of one thousand dollars by note payable the
 15th day of March 1839 and bearing the same date of this Indenture which debt with the legal interest
 accruing thereon the said John Wilson is willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture witnesseth
 that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar of
 lawful money of Virginia to the said John Wilson in hand paid by the said B. E. Daughtery here
 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the
 said John Wilson hath given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed
 and by these presents doth give grant bargain sell alien enfeoff release and confirm to the said Benj^e
 E Daughtery his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County
 of Southampton in the State of Virginia containing one hundred acres be the same more or less
 and bounded by the Lands of Benjamin Devany Thomas N Story and others also all my personal
 estate that I am possessed with consisting of a Mare and Colt 2 cows & pigs a bed & parson's table
 1 Desk 1 press 1 chest one Clock & chairs Crochery ware &c knives & forks kitchen furniture &c forming
 utensils 1 gig & harness 1 Cart & wheels 2 Cows & Calves 1000^l Salted pork 1 saddle & spurs from 20^l
 Bt^l Corn from 1800 to 2000^l further also my ensuing crop for this present year 1839 with all the rest
 the appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of Land belonging or in any way appertaining and all the rest
 right title and interest of the said John Wilson in and to the said granted or intended to be granted tract
 or parcel of Land and premises. To have and to hold the said hereby granted tract or parcel of Land
 and premises with its appurtenances and all the other personal property hereby conveyed unto the said
 Benj^e E Daughtery his heirs Exec^r adm^r and assigns forever and to the only purpose and behoof of him
 The said B. E. Daughtery his heirs Exec^r adm^r and assigns forever. And the said John Wilson for him
 self his heirs Exec^r adm^r doth hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said B. E. Daugh
 tery his heirs Exec^r adm^r and assigns forever in manner and form following That is to say That the
 said John Wilson his heirs Exec^r adm^r and assigns the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land and premises
 with the appurtenances together with all the other personal property hereby conveyed unto the
 said B. E. Daughtery his heirs Executors adm^rs and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall
 and will warrant and forever defend by these presents; upon trust nevertheless That the said
 Benj^e E Daughtery his heirs Exec^r and adm^r shall permit the said John Wilson to remain
 in quiet and peaceable possession of the said tract or parcel of Land and premises with its
 appurtenances together with all the other personal property hereby conveyed and take the profits
 thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said sum of one thousand dollars
 either in whole or in part and then upon this further trust that they or any two or either of them
 at the survivor of them or the heirs Exec^r adm^r or assigns of such survivor shall and will as soon
 after the happening of such default of payment as they or any or either of them or the survivor
 of them or the heirs Exec^r adm^r or assigns of such survivor may think proper or the said
 Thomas N Story his Exec^r adm^r or assigns shall request sell the said tract of Land and
