 of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars to them in hand paid by the said Thomas L Jones & James H Schell  
 and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said  
 John D Hart and Sophia E his wife have granted bargained and sold alioing enfeoffed and confirmed  
 and by these presents do give and grant to the said Thomas L Jones & James H Schell their heirs or assigns a certain lot in the town of Farmville  
 designated as No 17 also the back or Stable lot adjoining the same and now occupied by Edmund Wilson  
 Harris as a Tavern & being the said lot or parcel of land conveyed by Augustine G. Bush trustee  
 to John P. Mason Richard Stewart & John D Hart and from the said Edmund Gump and the said  
 Richard Stewart to the said John D Hart which may be duly registered to the said John D Hart  
 with all the buildings and improvements thereon and its appurtenances of every description and
