 This Indenture made this 12 March one thousand eight hundred and thirty one between Edward G. Hunt of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Ormande Bryant of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth That the said Edward G. Hunt for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars to him in hand paid over before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof he doth hereby acknowledged and himself to be thereunto fully satisfied contented and paid have granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien & confirm unto the said Ormande Bryant one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and containing by Estimation two hundred and twelve acres (be the same more or less) and lying on the south side of Crab Creek bounding the Lands of Robert Williams (formerly George Williams) John Hart & Jonathan Bostick (formerly George Williams) the State line Ormande Bryant and Williams Rivers and bounded as follows (Viz) Beginning at a pine stump on the Sandy Bridge Road at corner of Robert Williams Land Thence along his line S. 58 degrees W. 131 poles to a live oak Thence N. 33 degrees W. 20 poles to a dead oak Thence N. 50 degrees W. 50 poles to a hickory Thence S. 22 degrees W. 167 poles to a pine a corner of John Harls Land Thence along his line S. 16 degrees E. 24 poles to a pine Thence S. 22 degrees E. 20 poles to a live oak Thence S. 44 degrees E. 34 poles to a pine Thence S. 31 degrees E. 37 poles to a live oak then the State line Thence along the State line to a black Gum in the branch Ormande Bryants line then his line down said Branch across the great branch Thence up a small branch to a pine standing at the head of said branch Thence along said Bryants line to the Public Road Thence down the said Road to a hickory stump Williams owns line Thence along his line to the beginning. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land containing two hundred and twelve acres with all rights people privileges and appurtenances to the said Ormande Bryant and his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Bryant his heirs and assigns forever And the said Edward G. Hunt for himself his heirs Executors and Admrs. doth covenant and agree to and with the said Bryant his heirs & assigns That the above granted premises are free and clear of all charges and incumbrances whatsoever and That the said Edward G. Hunt his heirs Executors and Admrs. shall and well warrant and defend the same to the said Bryant his heirs and assigns against the claims and demands of all persons whatsoever and shall at any time hereafter upon request make and execute such further and other conveyances or assurances in the Law for the better confirming and sure making of the said premises to the said Ormande Bryant his heirs and assigns as by him the said Ormande Bryant his heirs or assigns shall be devised advised or required.
