This Indenture made and entered into this 22^d day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and thirty nine Between Byrd Lundy and Rebecca I his wife of the County of Southampton and
State of Virginia of the one part and James Harris of the County and State aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Byrd Lundy and Rebecca I his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one
hundred dollars to them in hand paid by the said James Harris at or before the sealing and delivery
of these presents. The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents
do and each of us do bargain & sell unto the said James Harris his heirs and assigns a certain tract or
parcel of Land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid and on the south side of the Three
Creeks containing by estimation Fifty and 1/4 acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows
(to wit) by the Lands of Edwin B. Bland James Drewry and the lands of the said James Harris
together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging to the said tract or parcel
of Land. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land together with all the appurtenances
thereunto belonging to the said James Harris his heirs and assigns forever. and the said Byrd Lundy and Rebecca I his
wife for themselves their heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and
appurtenances before mentioned unto the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Harris.
his heirs Executors and assigns free from the Claim or Claims of them the said Byrd Lundy and
