This Indenture made and entered into this the 10th day of April AD 1839 between Edwards Butts
 appointed special Commissioner for the purpose of the one hundred dollars to him by the
 court of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia. Whereas by a decree of the Circuit Court
 of Law and Chancery for the County aforesaid made on the 2^d day of November 1835 was a cause in equity
 therein pending between Allen Edwards & others Plaintiff against Thomas King
 of Harrison I Griffin & others Defendants it was among other things decreed and ordered that Thomas King
 who was appointed Commissioner for the purpose after giving thirty days notice by advertisement first
 at the front door of the Courthouse of this County and at one or more public places in the neighborhood
 proceed to sell upon a credit of nine months the real estate including the necessary land
 in the several lands allotted to the defendant Nancy as her dower which real estate is divided
 as follows to wit One Tract Containing one hundred and forty acres purchased of Thomas Pitt
 subject to the dower estate therein as allotted by order of the County Court to Mary Bradshaw in
 Thirty two acres thereof and the said Nancy Griffins dower was forty one and one half acres on
 one tract of Land Containing one hundred and fifteen and two thirds which was given to the
 said Harrison I Griffin at the death of his mother by Elijah Griffin his deceased Father
 And Whereas the said Thomas R. Gray Commissioner aforesaid pursuant to the said decree
 made sale of the said lands and Bennett I Griffin became the purchaser at the price of
 hundred and fifty dollars. And whereas by another decree in the said cause on the 6th day of
 April 1839 it was among other things decreed and ordered that Edwards Butts as Commissioner
 execute to the purchaser a deed for the said lands. Now Therefore this Indenture witnesseth
 That the said Edwards Butts Commissioner for and in consideration of the promises and also of
 the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Bennett I
 Griffin the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained & sold & does by these
 presents grant bargain sell & convey unto the said Bennett I Griffin his heirs and assigns here
 to as in the decree first above referred to described. Viz one tract containing one hundred and
 forty acres purchased of Thomas Pitt above subject to the dower estate therein as allotted by order of
 the County Court to Mary Bradshaw in thirty two acres thereof and the said Nancy Griffin in
 forty one and one half acres also one tract of land containing one hundred and fifteen
 two thirds acres which was given to the said Harrison I Griffin at the death of his mother
 by Elijah Griffin his deceased Father. To have and to hold the said lands unto the said Bennett I Griffin
 his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Edwards Butts for himself his heirs executors and
 heirs Covenants to and with the said Bennett I Griffin his heirs and assigns that he will from
 time to time defend the said tract of land hereby conveyed with the appurtenances thereto
 belonging to the said Bennett I Griffin his heirs and assigns against the claims of the
 Edwards Butts his heirs and assigns and all persons claiming the same or any part thereof
 from through or under him the said Butts but against the claims of no other person whomsoever
 in witness whereof the said Edwards Butts have hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year
 first aforesaid
