This Indenture made the 25th of March one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between Joshua Doyal and his wife of the City of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part and James Williams of the of the other part Witness that the said Joshua Doyal for and on the behalf of ^{consideration of} three hundred dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said James Williams the receipt whereof the said Joshua Doyal and Conomy his wife both acknowledge themselves amply satisfied and paid to the grantee hereinafter set at record expressed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said James Williams to him and to his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and parish of St. Andrew being tract of land formerly transferred from Joseph Council to Benjamin Joyner containing a late survey made by the County Surveyor of the County of Southampton containing one hundred and twenty five acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a maple standing in the branch called the mowed branch on the side of the road leading from Black water bridge to Bannons Ferry running thence S 88° E 32 poles to the turning the said Branch thence S 80° E 10 poles thence S 77° E 10 poles thence S 77° E 10 poles to the Thence N 74° East 30 poles thence S 77° E 112 poles to a black gum standing in Rogers Branch where the branch and process comes together thence down the said Branch S 63° E 32 poles to a large green pine a corner in Joshua Corbitts line thence on the side of the said Rogers branch thence S 63° E 32 poles to a small post oak a corner in the line called the new patent line thence S 60° E 17 poles along the new patent line so called to a black pine a corner of Thomas Doves and Hardy both standing in the south prong of Rogers branch thence North 63° West 62 poles to a large oak pine a corner of the said Hardy both standing in the same Rogers branch thence North 63° West 62 poles to a pine a corner of Hardy both at a ditch ^{was} the said both but not now the corner of field thence S 76° E 30 poles to a dead pine a corner in the line now called Richard Beaton's line formerly James Joyner's line thence along the ditch line of Baker Joyner and the said land as the crop lines runs S 76° E 30 poles to a small black oak a corner of James Scott standing on the side of the road aforesaid and from thence down the said road N 63° E 60 poles to the foot of the hill with all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards and water courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of land to have and to hold the same unto the said James Williams to him and to his heirs and assigns forever and the said Joshua Doyal and Conomy his wife doth by these presents covenant and warrant well give defend all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same any part or parts thereof In Witness whereof the said Joshua Doyal and Conomy his wife doth hereunto set their hands and seals this day and date above written
