This indenture made the 25<sup>th</sup> of March in thousand eight hundred and thirty nine between Joshua Doyal and his wife of the City of Southampton State of Virginia of the one part and James Williams of the of the other part witness that the said Joshua Doyal for and on behalf of <sup>consideration of</sup> three hundred dollars good and lawful money of Virginia have in hand paid by the said James Williams the receipt whereof the said Joshua Doyal and Conny his wife both acknowledge themselves amply satisfied and paid to the granted Benjamin, sold & conveyed in possession and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto the said James Williams to him and to his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and parish of Newburg being tract of land formerly transferred from Jesse Council to Benjamin Joyner containing a like survey made by the County Surveyor of the County of Southampton containing one hundred and twenty five acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a maple standing in the branch called the mowed branch on the side of the road leading from Black water bridge to Browns Ferry running Thence S 80° E 32 poles to the turning the said Branch Thence S 80° E 10 poles Thence S 75° E 100 poles to the Thence N 74° East 30 poles Thence S 77° E 112 poles to a black gum standing in Reggs Branch where the branch and process corner by the mouth Thence down the said Branch S 2° E 32 poles to a large green pond a corner in Joshua Corbitts line standing on the side of the said Reggs branch Thence S 27° W 30 poles to a small post oak a corner in the line called the new patent line Thence S 20° W 97 poles along the new patent line so called to a black Pine a corner of Thomas Loves and Harry Cobb standing on the South prong of Reggs branch Thence North 83° W 26 poles to a large oak pine a corner of the said Harry Cobb standing on the same Reggs branch Thence N 29° West 62 poles to a pine a corner of Harry Cobb at a ditch ~~was~~ the said Cobb but not now the corner of field Thence S 76° W 90 poles to a dead pine a corner in the line now called Richard Beaters line formerly James Joyners line Thence along the ditch line of Baker Joyner and the said land as the crop finer runs N 25° W 86 poles to a small black oak a corner of James Lovell standing on the side of the road aforesaid and from Thence down the said road N 63° E 60 poles to the first Nations with all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards meadows and water courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of land to have and to hold the same unto the said James Williams to him and to his heirs and assigns forever and the said Joshua Doyal and Conny his wife doth by these presents covenant well grant & confirm and the said James Williams his heirs and that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend all right titles claims or demands of any persons or persons claiming or demanding the same any part of said Thence of In witness whereof the said Joshua Doyal and Conny his wife doth hereunto set their hands and seals This day and date above written
