To have and to hold the said lot or parcel of Land with the Tenements and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Hordard his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only purpose and intent - know the said Henry Hordard his heirs and assigns forever and the said Septe. S. Burham & Mariah his wife for themselves of their heirs the said lot or parcel of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned are unto the said Henry Hordard his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Septe. S. Burham and Mariah his wife or either of them or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents. So M. This Indenture made this 8th day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine between John S. Draker and Sarah A. his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Etheldreda Draker of said County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John S. Draker as well for and in consideration of the natural love and affections which he has and bears for his wife Sarah A. as of five dollars lawful money of the United States to him in hand by the said Etheldreda Draker at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents for himself and his heirs do give grant Bargain sell alien enfeoff release and confirm to the said Etheldreda Draker his heirs and assigns all his lands Tenements and hereditaments lying and bounded to the South East by the County of Southampton together with the appurtenances thereto belonging all his horses cattle sheep hogs and stock of every description together with his household and his other furniture and all his other property of every description and kind. To have and to hold the same to him the said Etheldreda Draker his heirs and assigns. In Trust nevertheless for the following uses and purposes viz. For the occupation and use of the said Sarah A. wife of John S. Draker so long as she shall live and for the use and occupation of such child or children as the said Sarah may leave living at the time of her death lawfully begotten on her body by the said S. S. Draker and the said Etheldreda Draker on his part doth hereby covenant & agree well and truly to keep and perform the trust herein imposed upon her.
