Williamson of Lydia Lundy and wife and bounded as follows to wit by the lands of Job Harry deceased Job Williams deceased and Mr Wright deceased to have and to hold all my interest in the said tract or parcel of land the tenement house thereon and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold to the said Thomas B Williamson his heirs and assigns forever: and the said Benjamin Williamson for himself his heirs the said interest with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned to the said Thomas B Williamson his heirs and assigns free from the claims or liens of him the said Benjamin Williamson his and all and every person whatsoever shall will and do warrant and defend forever by these presents. This indenture made this first day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between Jeff Bankford of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and William Lambford of the same County and state of the said Witenpele. That for and in consideration of the mutual love and affection which I bear to my son William Lambford as well as for the further consideration of one dollar to me in hand paid by the said William Lambford at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said William Lambford his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land lying on Black Water River in said County known by the name of Fish Island containing one hundred and five acres and bounded as follows (to wet) Beginning at a black Gum and running at E. W 2 P. to the hill or high Land thence along the high banks lading on the lands of Powells estate George Camps and the old Williams Tract to Black water River thence along the various courses of said River to the beginning together with all and every part thereof the reversions and reversions remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and every parcel thing To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land unto him the said William Lambford his heirs and assigns forever.
