This Indenture made and entered into the seventh day of March Eighteen hundred and thirty nine
between Mary E. Blunt formerly of Southampton County Virginia and now a resident of Dallas County in
the State of Alabama of the first part and Mary Burrill of the County of Southampton on the State of
Virginia of the second part. Witnesseth that the said Mary E. Blunt for and in consideration of the sum of
Twelve hundred and thirty two dollars and ninety four cents to her in hand paid or secured to be paid at a before
the delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged has granted bargained and sold and
by these presents does grant bargain and sell unto the said Mary Burrill her heirs and assigns all her right
title interest and estate in a certain tract of Land lying in the said County of Southampton of which Richard
Blunt died seized and possessed containing by recent survey nine hundred and eighty four acres more
less the said tract of Land having been devised by the said Richard Blunt to his wife Jane Blunt for life
and upon her death the same become vested in Caroline the wife of Benjamin I. Harrison Amn I. the
wife of William I. Jeffries the said Mary E. Blunt and Jane E. Blunt Children of the said Richard Blunt
deceased and which tract was purchased by the said Mary Burrill on the 17th day of January 1838 and the
interest of the said Caroline and the said Amn I. in the said tract to wit one fourth such has been
conveyed by deed executed by the said Benjamin I. Harrison and Caroline his wife and William I.
Jeffries and Amn I. his wife bearing date 30th day of September 1838 and admitted to Record in
the Court of Southampton County to which said deed the said Mary E. Blunt is also a party and has
subscribed her name Thence at the time she was under the age of twenty one years and having since
attained to the age of twenty ^{one} years she now intends by these presents to make a full and official con-
veyance of her interest in the said tract of Land being one fourth part to the said Mary Burrill
her heirs and assigns with all and singular the benefits and appurtenances thereto belonging
To have and to hold the same unto the said Mary Burrill her heirs and assigns forever of her the
said Mary E. Blunt the interest hereby convey being an undivided interest in the said tract
of Land and the said Mary E. Blunt hereby covenants with the said Mary Burrill for herself
and her heirs that she well warrant and defend the title to the premises hereby conveyed unto the
said Mary Burrill her heirs and assigns against the claims of all persons whomsoever In witness
whereof the said Mary E. Blunt has hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal the day and
