and delivery of these presents the Receipt here by acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these
presents do bargain and sell unto The said Daniel H Dranggoles his heirs and assigns forever a certain
piece of land with the appurtenances attached thereto situated lying and being in the County of Southampton
aforesaid containing six and one half acres and bounded as follows North by Indians Land South
by the land of Thodore Inzgant known as the ~~Marshall~~ land East commencing at a dogwood stump
and running N 35° E 10 poles to a Wh. Oak N 48° E 23.64 p a large pine in a branch N 35° N 14.32 p
a peach to the Indian line Thence N 71 W 29.24 p to a Red Oak a former corner between Inzgant
and Dranggoles Thence S 18 W 41.34 p to the beginning. Together with all and singular the appur-
tenances thereto belonging The reversions and reversions remaineth and remaineth yearly and
other rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold
The said piece of land with the appurtenances and all and singular the premises herein mentioned
or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Daniel H Dranggoles
his heirs and assigns forever and The said Thodore Inzgant and Martha his wife for themselves and
their heirs The said piece of land with the appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Daniel
H Dranggoles his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of all and every person or persons
whoever shall will and in warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof the

This Indenture made this 25th day of May one thousand eight hundred & thirty seven
between James Edwards Butts of Southampton . . . of one part and Henry Anderson of the County
of Southampton of the second part: whereas by a decree of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery
at Richmond directed by law to be holden for the County of Southampton pronounced on the Thore day of April
last past in a cause then depending thereon between James Turner James Pope both of the
County of Buchanan & William D Phillips Complainants and Stephens Mendenhall surviving administrator
of Nathaniel Rockelle deceased and their defendants it was decreed and ordered that the said James
Butts should sell at public auction for so much ⁱⁿ cash as might be necessary to defray the expenses
of the suit and of the sale of that much for cash. The lands in the County of Southampton
whereof Nathaniel Rockelle died seized as an estate of inheritance after advertisement for thirty
days previous to the sale the time and place of sale at the door of the Court house of South-
ampton County and at some public place near the premises and also in some newspaper

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
