Myrick acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and that she had willingly signed sealed & delivered the same and that she wished not to retract it. This Indenture made this 12th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine between Sarah Harvey Josiah & Elizabeth & Margaret J. his wife & Sarah J. Harvey of the County of Sandhorough and State of North Carolina of the one part and Joseph L. Murdough of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth That the said Sarah Harvey Josiah & Elizabeth and Margaret J. his wife & Sarah J. Harvey in consideration of Five hundred and Twenty seven dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Joseph L. Murdough at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph L. Murdough his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land willod to Sarah Harvey by Josiah Murdough her Father during her life & then to her two daughters Margaret J. Harvey and Sarah J. Harvey reference to the Will (will more fully appear) together with all the singular Tenements woods underwoods ways water advantages emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said tract of land belonging or appertaining to the same or any part thereof and the regions and recesses remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of land containing by recent survey one hundred & fifty five acres more or less and bounded by the lines of James D. Maupenburg Elizabeth Johnson Elsieu Soyner & William Peale with the Tenements hereditaments and all & singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Joseph L. Murdough his heirs and assigns forever (to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Joseph L. Murdough his heirs and assigns forever) and the said Sarah Harvey Josiah & Elizabeth & Margaret J. his wife and Sarah J. Harvey for themselves and their heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the premises & appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Joseph L. Murdough his heirs & assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Sarah Harvey Josiah & Elizabeth & Margaret J. his wife & Sarah J. Harvey or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all & every person or persons what soever shall will and do warrant and forever defend by these presents.
