This Indenture made this 12<sup>th</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand  
eight hundred and thirty nine between Sarah Harvey Josiah G Butchins & Margaret G his wife &  
Sarah I Harvey of the County of Nansemond and Isle of white and state of Virginia of the one part  
and Joseph G Murdough of the County of Southampton and state of course of the other part  
Witnesseth That the said Sarah Harvey Josiah Butchins and Margaret G his wife & Sarah  
I Harvey in consideration of Five hundred and Twenty seven dollars of lawful money of this  
Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Joseph G Murdough at or before the sealing  
and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have bargained and  
sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph  
G Murdough his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land willed to Sarah Harvey by Josiah  
Murdough her Father during her life of them to her two daughters Margaret G Harvey and Sarah  
I Harvey reference to the will (will more fully appear) together with all the singular Tenements  
woods underwoods ways waters advantages emoluments hereditaments and appurtenances whichever  
to the said tract of land belonging or appertaining to the same or any part thereof and the  
reversion and reversions remainder and remanences yearly and other rents issues and profits  
thereof and of every part and parcel thereof. It have and to hold the said tract of land  
containing by recent Survey one hundred & Fifty five acres more or less and bounded by the lands of  
James D Mapenburg Elizabeth Johnson Eliza Saylor & William Peale with the tenements her-  
editaments and all & singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be  
bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and  
appurtenances unto the said Joseph G Murdough his heirs and assigns forever (to and for the  
only proper use and behoof of him the said Joseph G Murdough his heirs and assigns forever) and  
the said Sarah Harvey Josiah Butchins & Margaret G his wife and Sarah I Harvey for themselves  
and their heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the premises & appurtenances  
before mentioned unto the said Joseph G Murdough his heirs & assigns free from the claim or  
claims of them the said Sarah Harvey Josiah G Butchins & Margaret G his wife & Sarah I Harvey  
or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all & every person or persons or persons what  
soever shall well and do warrant and forever defend by these presents. In witness whereof
