This Indenture made and entered into this day of one Thousand eight hundred and thirty eight between William Suckins of the County of Southampton of the first part and Bratton Davis (free negro) of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Suckins hath for and in consideration of the sum of twenty dollars in hand paid to the said Bratton Davis his heirs or assigns: a certain lot of land lying in the County of Southampton and immediately between the lands of Alfred Bratton Bratton Davis and William Suckins the said land and on the East side of the road leading from Mine Bridge to Smithfield supposed to contain five acres or thereabouts more or less. The Title to the said Land the said William Suckins doth bind himself and his heirs to defend unto the said Bratton Davis his heirs and assigns forever. This Indenture made and entered into on the thirtieth day of April in the year of our Lord One Thousand eight hundred and thirty nine between Josiah Furguson of Clinton County and State of Ohio of the one part and Henry S. Nelson of Southampton County and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Josiah Furguson for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and three dollars and twenty five cents good and lawful money to him in hand by the said Henry S. Nelson at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said Henry S. Nelson his heirs and assigns forever all the right title interest claim or demand of him the said Josiah Furguson under the last will and Testament of his Father William Furguson dec'd of in and to the tract or parcel of land of which said William Furguson died possessed situate lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton & Parish of Saint Luke and bounded by the same of John Hargrave (formerly Edmund Vicks) and Patience Vicks. To have and to hold all the aforesaid Right title interest claim or demand of him the said Josiah Furguson under the will aforesaid of in and to the above described tract or parcel of land unto him the said Henry S. Nelson his heirs and assigns forever and the said Josiah Furguson for himself his heirs Executors and administrators doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Henry S. Nelson his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title vested in him under the will aforesaid of in and to the aforesaid tract or parcel of land against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever In Witness whereof the said Josiah Furguson hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written is
