Newson of the County of Southampton of the other part. Witnesseth That the said Charles N. Briggs and Mary Jane his wife for and in consideration of the sum of £. two hundred and Twenty dollars to them in hand paid by the said George A. W. Newson at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and by these presents do grant bargain sell and convey unto the said George A. W. Newson his heirs and assigns the interest which the said Briggs has in the lands alloted to Mrs. Ann Nicholson as her dower in the lands of her deceased husband Little Nicholson in the County of Southampton which interest the said Briggs purchased of Littleton R. Edwards trustee of it as per deed dated the 19th day of November 1833 and admitted to record in the Clerk's office of Southampton County Court on the same day will fully explain. To have and to hold the interest aforesaid unto him the said George A. W. Newson his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said George A. W. Newson his heirs and assigns forever and the said Charles N. Briggs and Mary Jane his wife for themselves their heirs & assigns hereby covenants to be with the said George A. W. Newson his heirs and assigns that they the said Charles N. Briggs & Mary Jane his wife will warrant and forever defend the interest aforesaid hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed unto him the said George A. W. Newson his heirs & assigns against the claim of themselves the said Briggs and wife or either of them and against the claims or claims of all and every other person whomsoever.
