Witnesseth that the said Thomas P Rives & Martha A his wife in consideration of the sum of one hundred & thirty dollars to them in hand paid or secured to be paid as aforesaid the receipting and delivery of these presents by the said George Newsome; have bargain'd and sold & by these presents do bargain & sell unto the said George Newsome a certain tract of land containing Sixty acres more or less the same being their interest in a tract of land held in dower by Mrs. Ann Nicholas adjoining the lands of George Blount Thomas Bluff and others together with all and singular the appurtenances to have and to hold the said tract of land unto the said George Newsome his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas P Rives & Martha A his wife for themselves and their heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances unto the said George Newsome his heirs & assigns free from the claims or claims of them the said Thomas P Rives & Martha his wife their heirs & of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall well and lawfully be or lawfully be hereafter.
