This Indenture made the first day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine Between James S. Williams of the one part and Jesse Parker of the other part both of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia. Witnesseth that the said James S. Williams for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Jesse Parker at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said James S. Williams hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents acknowledged to the said Jesse Parker his heirs and assigns the fee simple right and title in and of a certain tract or parcel of land at present in the occupancy of James Williams who is entitled to the use of the same during his natural life and after his death the fee simple title of the said land is vested in the said James S. Williams as well appears by reference to the last will and testament of Jeremiah Weston which said tract of land was conveyed by Elisha Gardner &c. to William Lawrence by deed of bargain and sale for uses and purposes therein expressed as will appear by reference to the record of Southampton County and is bounded as follows beginning at a black gum in the road leading from South Dury to Monroe Spring in the late Henry Gardner's line and East by said road South by the said Elisha Gardner and West & North by the said Gardner and the heirs of the said Henry Gardner do^c. containing fifty acres more or less together with all and singular the divisions and recesses remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits thereon and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Jesse Parker his heirs and assigns forever And the said James S. Williams for himself and his heirs the said tract or parcel of land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Jesse Parker his heirs and assigns free from the claim of him the said James S. Williams his heirs and assigns and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall will and so covenant and power depend by these presents. In Witness whereof the said James S. Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of five thousand dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth for the payment whereof well and truly by these presents made we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and administrators jointly and severally partly The Conditions of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound James Clayton has been appointed by the Court of Southampton County to serve as Constable within the term for the term of two years from the date hereof. Now if the said James Clayton shall well and truly discharge the duties of the office of Constable in the said County during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void & due to remain in full force & effect
