Now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the promises and also for the further consideration of one dollar to the said William M. Hills lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton also one negro man named Kit. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and slaves aforesaid unto the said Lawrence & Daughtry his heirs executors administrators and assigns upon trust nevertheless that the said Lawrence & Daughtry his heirs executors administrators and assigns shall as soon as conveniently can after the 22^d of Decr next ensuing and having advertised the time and place of sale of the land and slaves aforesaid by three several advertisements one of which shall be posted up at the door of the Courthouse of the said County or some one Court day previous to the day of sale proceed to sell to the highest bidder for
