This Indenture made this 25th day of July one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine between
Mary Drake of the County of Southampton of the one part and James J Williams of the County of Loudoun of the
other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the just sum of ten dollars Virginia money
by the said James J Williams in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents
the receipt whereof the said Mary Drake doth hereby acknowledge thereof acquit and from
discharge the said James J Williams his heirs and assigns forever and by these presents
the said Mary Drake hath granted bargained and sold aliened released and confirmed and
by these presents doth grant bargaine and sell alien release and confirm unto the said James
Williams his heirs and assigns forever part of that tract or parcel of land wherein the said Mary
Drake now lives being the same land that John Drake purchased of Braxton Seymour deceased
lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Alluvury containing by estimation
one acre and a half to the same more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a postmark tree
on side of the main road leading from Black water bridge to Jerusalem thence to the fork of
the Road there down the main road to a stake near a apple tree thence a strait line to the
first station together with all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards
wings water and water courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said
tract or parcel of Land. To have and to hold the same unto the said James J Williams
to him and to his heirs and assigns forever and the said attorney Drake doth by these presents
covenant and grant to and with the said James J Williams his heirs and assigns forever
that she will by these presents warrant and forever defend all right titles claims &
demands of any person claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcels In
