This Indenture made this 18<sup>th</sup> day of July in the year of our lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine between Levi Waller Son of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part and James B Lundy of the said County and State of the second part and Samuel Drowry of the said County and State of the Third part, Whereas the said Samuel Drowry has this day become security for the said Levi Waller Son in the sum of fifteen hundred and fifty dollars which amount is due by note executed to Joseph T blood bearing interest from 18<sup>th</sup> July Eighteen hundred and thirty nine which debt and interest together with all cost which may accrue the said Levi Waller Son is willing and desirous to secure the said Samuel Drowry for his becoming security in the above named amount. Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of one dollar to the said Waller in hand paid by the said James B Lundy at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Waller hath given granted bargained sold released and confirmed and by these presents do give grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said James B Lundy his executors administrators and assigns forever all the tract of land on which the said Waller now resides lying and being in the County of Southampton containing five hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows on the north by the land of Jno A Turner, F. T. Ridley and Peter Edwards on the East by the land of Peter Edwards On the South by the land of Peter Edwards and on the West by the land of Francis T Ridley. Also the following slaves Thomas Alfred and Joseph with all and singular the appurtenances to the said tract of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and all the estate right title and interest of the said Waller in and to the said granted or intended to be hereby granted tract of land and premises. To have and to hold the said hereby granted or intended to be hereby granted tract of land and premises together with all the aforementioned slaves unto the said James B Lundy his executors administrators or assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Jas B Lundy his executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Levi Waller Son for himself his executors administrators and assigns do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Jas B Lundy his executors administrators and assigns forever to warrant and defend by these presents the right and title of the said land and premises together with the aforementioned slaves against the claim or claims of any persons, whatsoever upon trust nevertheless that the said Jas B Lundy
