This Indenture made this 17th day of April in the year of our Lord aforesaid one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine between Bennet J. Griffin and Nancy Griffin his Mother & widow of Harrison J. Griffin dec'd of the one part and Allen Edwards of the other part all of the County of Southampton and Parish of Newway. Witnesseth that the said Bennet J. Griffin and Nancy Griffin for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand dollars good and Lawful money of Virginia. He accept whereof the said Bennet J. Griffin & Nancy Griffin doth acknowledge themselves amply satisfied and paid hath granted bargain and sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents hath granted bargain and sold unto Allen Edwards to him and his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises containing by estimation one hundred and forty five acres be the same more or less situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and Parish of Newway and bounded by the lines as follows beginning at a pine a corner tree in Matthew Wells line thence a line of marked trees in said Wells line to a lightwood slab a corner in the land belonging to the heirs of Shadrach Cobb dec'd. Thence down a small branch a line in said Cobb's land to Lewis Allen's line thence down said branch a line in said Allen's land to a pine a corner tree in Patrick Rows line thence a line of marked trees in said Rows line to the first station together with all houses Out houses outhouses buildings yards Gardens Orchards ways waters and water courses belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of land and the premises.
