from her husband and having the deed aforesaid fully explained to her she the said Eliza
Edwards acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and declared that she had willingly
and of her own accord signed sealed and delivered the same and that she wished not to
retract from it Given under our hands and seals this 30th day of April 1839.

This Indenture made and entered into this 21st day of January 1839 between James
Wick of the one part and John Waddell and John Wick of the other part all of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia except John Waddell who is a resident of
N.C. Wilmette whereas that Joseph N Wick conveyed by deed of trust bearing date the
15th of Sept. 1838 and recorded in the Clerk's office of Southampton County to the aforesaid
James Wick one tract of Land containing three hundred and sixty acres to the sum
more or less and bounded as follows to wit By land lands of John Denysor sold
by the lands of Jepa Wick by the lands of John Wick by the land of Mary F
Wick sister to the said Joseph to secure the payment of a certain bond due from the
said Joseph N Wick to John Waddell and John Wick all of which will appear by
reference to a deed of Record the said Joseph N Wick having failed to make payment
as stipulated and thereby violating the conditions annexed to the said deed
of trust The said tract of land was set up and sold on the 8th of January 1839 to the
highest bidder for cash having previously given due notice of the same by advertisement
now and for and in consideration of the premises and the sum of fifteen
hundred dollars cash in hand raised The sum for which the tract of land was bid
off by the said James Wick both granted Burgoed and sold unto John
Waddell and John Wick the above named tract of Land being the sum which
belong to Joseph N Wick particularly described in the deed of trust with all the
incumbrances or reversions remainder or remainders yearly and other rents issues and
profits thereof and every part or parcel thereof To have and to hold the
said tract of Land with all the appurtenances herein before mentioned or
intended to be bargained and sold and every part or parcel thereof with every
of their rights members of unto the John Waddell and John Wick their
heirs and assigns forever and the said James Wick for himself and the
said tract of Land or such right thereunto as described unto the deed of trust
unto said John Waddell and John Wick his heirs or assigns free from the
claims of him the said James Wick or his heirs shall and will forever defend
