I Anselm Denson have this day bargained and sold and do hereby transfer & convey to  
George Gay and his heirs for the consideration of one hundred and twenty dollars to me paid  
a tract of land in the county of Southampton and state of Virginia containing by estimation  
ninety acres to the same more or less and bounded by the lands of George Gay, Washington  
Richard Hart Jeps Hart Larry Gay and George Gay The Postoffice Road & the Roadside  
branch down to the old Mill seat. To have and to hold the same to the said George  
Gay his heirs and assigns forever. I do covenant to the said George Gay that I and  
lawfully seized of said land have a good right to convey it and do further covenant  
and bind myself my heirs and representatives to warrant and forever defend the  
title to the said land and every part thereof to the said George Gay his heirs and  
assigns against the lawful claims of all persons what soever. Ad Witness my hands

This indenture made and entered into this 29<sup>th</sup> day of April in the year of our Lord in the  
eight hundred and thirty nine between F J Muhone and Martha his wife of the one part and  
John C Beale of the other part all of the county of Southampton & state of Virginia;  
Witnesseth that the said F J Muhone and Martha his wife for and in consideration  
of the sum of three hundred and eighty dollars to them in hand paid by the said  
John C Beale at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth  
grant bargain and sell unto the said John C Beale his heirs and assigns forever the  
following described Parcel or tract of Land (viz) The tract or parcel of Land which Martha  
Drake did deed seized and possessed of except whatever interest the heirs of Jesse B  
Drake did may have in unto the said tract or parcel of Land it being the same tract  
or parcel of Land which was allotted to the before mentioned Martha Drake in the  
division of her said Fathers lands Jeremiah Drake about the year 1826 as may be  
seen by commissioners report in the Clarke Office of Southampton Co. Va. and containing  
by estimation about ninety six acres to the same more or less. To have and to hold  
the said tract or parcel of Land with the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him  
the said John C Beale his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and  
benefit of him the said John C Beale his heirs and assigns forever: Except the before  
named Interest of the heirs of Jesse B Drake do? and the said F J Muhone and Martha  
his wife for themselves their heirs do not and admit by these presents forever have  
warrant and defend the right and title of the said tract or parcel of Land and do  
except the before mentioned interest which the said heirs of Jesse B Drake did may have
