This Indenture made and entered into this 20th day of August AD 1839 between Thomas L
Jones and Martha his wife and James H Sebrell of the County of Southampton of the one part
and Nicholas M Sebrell of the same County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Thomas L
Jones and Martha his wife and James H Sebrell for and in consideration of the sum of one
hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Nicholas M Sebrell the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant
bargain and sell unto the said Nicholas M Sebrell his heirs and assigns a certain piece or
parcel of land situate near the town of Jerusalem in the County aforesaid containing
by recent survey twenty nine acres two rods and seven ten poles and bounded as follows
to wit commencing at the road where the ditch crosses and running S 70° E 22 poles along
the middle of the ditch to a corner in a pond in line with M^{rs} Sebrells pastings thence
N 36° E 26.44 poles to a sycamore thence same course to a black gum at the main run
of a branch dividing the lands of James Rockwell from this tract thence along the various
courses of said branch to a pine a corner of said Rockwell M^{rs} Sebrell and this parcel
thence S 40° W 10.20 poles a small pine (trimmed up) thence S 29° W 20.67 poles to the
corner of Dr. Sebrells lot thence S 23° E along the back of lot 28.84 poles to corner of
said lot thence S 55° W 22.80 poles to the road thence along said road S 14.4 E 31.76 poles
to the beginning. To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of land with the appurtenances
thereunto belonging to him the said Nicholas M Sebrell his heirs and assigns to the only
purpose and behoof of him the said Nicholas M Sebrell his heirs and assigns forever
And the said Thomas L Jones and Martha his wife and James H Sebrell for themselves their
heirs executors and administrators do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said
Nicholas M Sebrell his heirs and assigns that they the said Thomas L Jones and
Martha his wife and James H Sebrell will forever warrant and defend the aforesaid
piece or parcel of land with its appurtenances unto the said Nicholas M Sebrell against
themselves and each of them and against all and every other person or persons whomsoever
