Williams for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand dollars and some money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said George B. Gury at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged. Hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto him the said George B. Gury his heirs and assigns forever. One certain piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and parish of Saint Luke containing somewhat more or less than the sum more or less and bounded as follows (to wit, Beginning at the fork of the old and new roads in the said Nathl. J. Williams and George B. Gury line Thence the various Courses of the old road along said George B. Gury line Thence Thence the new road along said Nathl. J. Williams line N 17 1/2° W 67 1/2 poles Thence N 29° W 235 poles to the River Mary. To have and to hold the above described piece or parcel of land and premises with the appurtenances Thence belonging or in any wise appertaining unto him the said George B. Gury his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said George B. Gury his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Nathl. J. Williams for him self his heirs Executors and Admrs. doth hereby covenant and agree to and with the said George B. Gury his heirs Executors and Admrs. and assigns that he will by these presents warrant and forever defend all the right and title of the aforesaid piece or parcel of land and premises against the claims or demands of all and every other person or persons whatsoever.
