Now this Indenture witnesseth that in consideration of the premises and for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Levi Waller to the said Peter Edwards the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Peter Edwards doth by these presents grant bargain sell release and confirm unto the said Levi Waller all the estate title and interest both in Law and equity which the said Peter Edwards has and possesses in and to the said tract or parcel of Land and its privileges improvements and appurtenances and in and to the upresaid Slaves conveyed by the aforesaid deed of Trust. To have and to hold the said Land and Slaves to him the said Levi Waller his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Peter Edwards for himself his heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Levi Waller his heirs and assigns that he the said Peter Edwards and his heirs executors and administrators will and shall forever warrant and defend the same to the said Levi Waller his heirs and assigns against the claim of himself and of all and every person claiming by Through or under him.
