This Indenture made this 18th day of February in the year of our Lord 1838 between Henry Pittman of the County of Southampton of the one part and Daniel R Butts of the County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that whereas William H Myrick of the same County died by his last will and testament bearing date the 25th of April 1836 convey unto the said Henry Pittman in trust all his Interest in a certain tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton bounded as follows that is to say by the lands of Gregory Rawlings s^r & J^r of Geo. A. B. Bucknans s^r & others at large to the land that William Myrick s^r died seized and possessed one fifth part whereof to belong to the said William H Myrick after the death of his Mother Temperance Myrick widow of the said William Myrick s^r and also all the right he the said William H Myrick had in any or can have of or unto two negro slaves namely Gordon and Jerry said Temperance Myrick life right particularly excepted but at her death he will be entitled to two fifths of said slaves to secure the payment of a certain sum of money due and owing to Benjamin Drury Curator of William L. Rochelle s^r and by bond payable on or before the 25th day of Oct. 1837 the said bond was executed by William H Myrick and Daniel R Butts as his security for the sum of eighty five dollars and the said Wm H Myrick being willing and desirous to waive the said Daniel R Butts for any life which he may sustain by reason of said security being as well more fully appearing by referring to the said deed of Trust which has been duly entered in the Clerk's office of the County Court of Southampton which said deed of Trust has been carried into execution.
