Witnesseth that the said Adams Jones Chassey his wife have and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty three dollars and thirty eight cents to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is retained by the said Solomon Johnson hereby acknowledged bargained and sold alienated and confirmed and by these presents to Solomon Johnson bargained and sold alienated and confirmed unto the said Solomon Johnson his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract and parcel of Land lying and being in Hampton County on the west side of the Road from Homes to Franklins Containing by Survey Forty eight acres and 2 Rods and is bounded as follows Beginning at a Red Oak Corner of this tract and Soltho Cobb in Bailey Boyants line thence N 9° E 92 p. along the said Bailey Boyants line to a post Oak thence the said line at 23° E 19 p. to a new corner of this tract and Jordan Boyants thence N 75° E 67 p. along a line of marked trees between this tract and Jordan Boyants to a red Oak at the west of marked trees between this tract and Jordan Boyants thence 228° E 66 p. along the said Road to a white Oak a corner of this tract and Carr Brown in Soltho Cobb's line thence up the run of a small Branch along a line of marked trees to a line between this tract and Soltho Cobb the various corners shown of 73 p. to a black gum in the said branch thence N 85° W 10 p. to a pine thence N 70° W 15 p. to the Beginning.
