This Instrument made and entered into this 12th day of October in the year AD 1839
between James H Gibell and Virginia his wife of the one part and Thomas B Jones of the other
part all of the County of Southampton. Whereas at the said James H Gibell and Virginia his
wife for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars to them in hand
paid by the said Thomas B Jones at or before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged) hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant
bargain sell and convey unto him the said Thomas B Jones his heirs and assigns, then the said
James H Gibell and Virginia his wife's undivided interest in several houses lots or parcels of land
that is to say one moiety in a certain house lot and piece of land situate in and adjoining
the Town of Jerusalem in the County aforesaid containing by survey seven and two thirds acres
more or less being the lot or piece of land conveyed by Thomas B Jones to Nicholas M. Jones & James H Gibell
bearing date the 12th day of March 1835 and admitted to Record on the same day. Also then the
said James H Gibell and Virginia his wife's interest in the lots #18 & 19 and a piece or parcel
of land adjoining the said lots in the Town of Jerusalem supposed to contain twenty more or
less half acres more or less which property was conveyed by Henry B Vaughan to Thomas B Jones
and James H Gibell by deed bearing the 1st day of January 1839 the boundaries whereof may
be seen by reference to the said deed admitted to Record in the Clerks office of said County
also their interest in a certain piece of land situate lying and being in the County
of Southampton called and known by the name of the Waddell tract whereof Noel Waddell
died seized and possessed containing by estimation One hundred and sixty seven acres more or
less and bounded by the lands of Johnnie Williford Thomas Johnson & others but for a more
particular description of the said Land and the boundaries thereof reference may be had to
the deed from John Waddell, executor of Noel Waddell to Thomas B Jones and James H Gibell
filed in the Clerks office the 15th day of January 1838 To have and to hold the said
property hereby conveyed or intended to be bargained and sold with all the privileges and appurtenances
thereunto belonging unto him the said Thomas B Jones his heirs and assigns to the only
proprietor and blesser of him the said Thomas B Jones his heirs and assigns forever
