This Indenture made and executed this 25th October AD one thousand eight hundred
 and thirty nine Between Dempsey Drake of the first part. Ichro Cobb of the second part
 and Jas. W. Murfee of the third part. all of the County of Southampton County and State of Virginia
 Witnesseth that the said Dempsey Drake hath for and in consideration of the sum of
 one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Jas. W. Murfee the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged bargained and sold and doth by these presents bargain and sell unto
 and confirm unto the said James W. Murfee his heirs and assigns forever the following
 property to wit: One horse Two feather beds and furniture two sows with pig and all his household
 and kitchen furniture; To have and to hold upon the following trust (to wit) The said Dempsey
 Drake stands partly indebted to the said Ichro Cobb in the sum of fifty five dollars which
 appears by note bearing date with these presents and on demand. The said Dempsey Drake
 being desirous to indemnify and secure the payment of the aforesaid debt on or before the 25th
 of next December. Witnesseth that if the said Dempsey Drake shall fail to pay the aforesaid
 debt with interest and all costs pertaining to these indentures on or before the 25th of next
 Dec. It shall then be lawful and right for the said James W. Murfee so soon as required
 by the said Ichro Cobb in writing to expose at public auction the aforesaid property
 for cash after having ten days notice of sale and satisfy the aforesaid debt with all costs
 pertaining to these indentures and the surplus if any pay over to the said Dempsey Drake
