I Nancy Griffin of & for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to Winston Griffin of & as well as for the further consideration of one dollar in hand paid by the said Winston Griffin at or before the making and delivery of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have given and granted and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Winston Griffin his Executors administrators and assigns the following property to wit Three further beds and furniture three chest half dozen Chairs one large Iron St three cast iron work stoves one sow and ten pigs and eight fat hogs. To have and to hold the said property unto the said Winston Griffin his Executors administrators and assigns forever and the said Winston Griffin is to help to support me the said Nancy Griffin as long as I shall live and the Nancy Griffin for herself her Executors administrators the said property unto the said Winston Griffin his Executors administrators and assigns against the claim of her the said Nancy Griffin her Executors administrators and against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall and will understand and forever defend them by these presents.
