Womble that we we lawfully seized of said land have a good right to convey it and that same  
is unencumbered we do further covenant and bind ourselves our heirs and representatives to warrant  
and forever defend the title to the said land & every part thereof to the said Williams Womble  
his heirs and assigns against the lawful claims of all persons whatsoever. At Williams own house

House and garden as they are now placed, a tract of land in the state of Virginia and County of  
Southampton containing by estimation Sixty five acres to the same more or less and lying immediately  
in the fork of the Proctor and Barbacue Roads and bounded by the lands of James B Nequashet  
John Brownlee and Benjamin Hart it being the tract of land I purchased from my Father  
John Womble a few days ago and also the land wherond he now resides. To have and to hold the  
same to the said John Holloman his heirs and assigns forever I do covenant to the said John Holloman  
that I am lawfully seized of said land have a good right to convey it and that the same is  
unencumbered I do further covenant and bind myself my heirs and representatives to warrant  
and forever defend the title to the said land and every part thereof to the said John Holloman
