This Indenture made this 22^d day of Nov. in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and thirty eight
between Zachariah Blythe and Nancy & his wife of the County of Northampton and State of North Carolina of
the one part and Fielding S. Mahons of the County of Southampton & State of Virginia of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Zachariah Blythe & Nancy & his wife for and in consideration of the sum
of twenty two dollars and fifty cents lawful money of the State of Virginia to him in hand paid by
the said F. S. Mahons at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is
hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain
and sell and convey unto the said F. S. Mahons his heirs and assigns forever the following described
parcels of land (viz) one fourth part of the undivided tract or parcel of land which Martha Drake did
and seized and possessed of it being the same tract or parcel of land which was allotted to the before
mentioned Martha Drake in the divisions of her deceased Father's lands Iremiah Drake about the year
1826 as may be seen by reference to the Commissioner's report in the Clerk's office of Southampton Co. Va.
and containing by estimation about ninety six acres be it the same more or less and all the
interest which in the said Blythe & Nancy & his wife has did have or may have in the same
land allotted to Mary Drake dec^d in the divisions of the lands of her dec^d husband Samuel
Drake which they Blythe & wife became heir to by the death of Martha Drake Saml Drake dec^d
W. Drake and Mary Drake their mother and also Elija Brooke dec^d formerly Elija Drake.
To have and to hold the said tract or parcels of land with the appurtenances thereto belonging
unto him the said F. S. Mahons his heirs and assigns forever. to & for the only proper use and
 behoof of him the said F. S. Mahons his heirs and assigns forever and the said Zachariah
Blythe & Nancy & his wife for themselves their heirs exec^s & administrators by these presents
forever transfer warrant and defend the right and title of said lands to him the said F. S.
Mahons his heirs and assigns against the claims or demand of all and every person whomsoever
