 we bind ourselves our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally by these presents sealed
 with our seals and dated this 18th day of November 1839.

Examination
 The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Samuel H Holmes was
 on the 21st day of October 1839 by the school commissioners in and for the County of Southampton named
 their treasurer for the year ending on the 31st day of December 1840. Now if the said Samuel H Holmes
 shall faithfully apply and account for all money which may come to his hands by virtue of his
 office and shall perform and execute all and every act and thing appertaining to his office according
 to law then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue as

 This Indenture made and entered into this seventh day of November AD 1839 between William
 M Wills of the first part Joe Moore of the second part and William A Spurk of the third part all
 of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the said William M Wills stands justly indebted to the said William A Spurk by two bonds one for the sum of Fifty
 four dollars and 67/100 bearing date the 28th day of December and the other for the sum of Forty
 dollars & 25/100 and bearing date the 16th day of April 1838 which the said William M Wills long
 willing and desirous to secure. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of
 The premises and also for the further sum of one dollar to the said William M Wills in
 hand paid by the said John Moore at and before the making and delivery of these presents
 (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) he the said William M Wills hath given granted
 bargained and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said
 John Moore his heirs executors administrators and assigns all what tract of Land of which
 the late Joshua Gardner died seized and possessed and wherein he died at the time of his
 death and now occupied and possessed by the said William M Wills lying and being in the
 aforesaid County of Southampton. Also one Negro man named Robt. To have and to hold the
 said tract or parcel of land and slave aforesaid unto the said Joe Moore his heirs executors administrators
 and assigns forever upon trust nevertheless that the said Joe Moore his heirs executors administrators
 and assigns shall as soon as he conveniently can after the 22nd day of March next insuring and
 having advertised the time and place of sale of the land and slave aforesaid by three several
 advertisements one of which shall be posted up at the door of the courthouse of said County in
 some convenient place to the day of sale proceed to sell to the highest bidder for ready
 money the tract of land and slave herein before mentioned and out of the money arising
 from such sale; first pay and satisfy all reasonable charges attending the said sale therefor
 to William A Spurk the rate agreed with lawful interest thereon from this date until
 paid and the balance if any be shall pay to the said William M Wills or to his heirs or
