This Indenture made and executed this 21st day of October AD one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine Between Solomon Johnson of the first part Seth's Cabb of the second part and Jos W. Bluffe of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of N.H. Witnesseth that the said Solomon Johnson hath for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged bargained and sold and by these presents bargain and sell alienate and confirm unto the said Jos W. Bluffe his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract and parcel of land in Southampton County on the County Road from Holmes to Franklin Depot containing by Survey Forty eight and a half acres it being the parcel of Land Adams Jones purchased of Jordan Bryant and Sally his mother and Martha Bryant his wife and is bounded as follows of record in the Clerk's Office of the County from thence the said Jordan Bryant Sally Bryant and Martha Bryant to Adams Jones which land and parcel of land has since been purchased of the said Adams Jones by the said Solomon Johnson as he does from the said Adams Jones by Abigail his wife. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract and parcel of land upon the following trust Viz The said Solomon Johnson stands justly indebted to Adams Jones in the sum of Fifty six dollars and Six Cents which appears by note bearing date the 21st day of October 1839 On demand the 21st day of next December and the said Seth's Cabb security to the said Adams Jones the said Solomon Johnson being desirous to secure and indemnify the said Seth's Cabb from the payment of the aforesaid debt. Witnesseth that if said Solomon Johnson shall fail to pay the aforesaid debt on demand it shall then being lawful and right for the said Jos W. Bluffe as soon as required by the said Seth's Cabb in writing to expose the aforesaid tract and parcel of land after having given ten day notice of the time and place of sale at public auction to the highest bidder for cash and discharge the aforesaid debt and all costs pertaining to this Indenture whomever surplus if any pay over to the aforesaid Solomon Johnson or order.
