This Indenture made and executed this 24th day of Oct: AD one thousand eight hundred and thirty nine Between Solomon Johnson of the first part Ichro Cobb of the second part and Jas. W. of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of N. C. Witnesseth that the said Solomon Johnson hath for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged bargained and sold and by these presents bargained and sold absolute and confirms unto the said Jas. W. Mifflin his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract and parcel of land in Southampton County on the County Road from Holman to Frankton Depot containing by survey Forty eight and a half acres it being the parcel of Land Adams Jones purchased of Jordan Bryant and Sally his mother and Martha Bryant his wife and is bounded as per deed of Record in the Blks Office of Southampton from thow the said Jordan Bryant Sally Bryant and Martha Bryant to Adams Jones which tract and parcel of Land has never been purchased of the said Adams Jones by the said Solomon Johnson as per deed from the said Adams Jones & his wife. To have and to hold the aforesaid tract and parcel of Land upon the following trust Viz. The said Solomon Johnson stands justly indebted to Adams Jones in the sum of Fifty six dollars and Six Cents which appears by note bearing date the 25th day of October 1833 On demand the 25th day of next December and the said Ichro Cobb security to the said Thos Johnson for his living disburse to secure and indemnify the said Ichro Cobb from the payment of the aforesaid debt. Witnesseth that if said Solomon Johnson shall fail to pay the aforesaid debt on demand it shall then bring lawful and right for the said Jas. W. Mifflin as soon as requisite by the said Ichro Cobb in writing to expose the aforesaid tract and parcel of Land after having given ten days notice of the time and place of sale at public auction to the highest bidder for cash and discharge the aforesaid debt and all costs pertaining to this Indenture and the overplus if any pay over to the aforesaid Solomon Johnson. or order.
