This Indenture made this 20<sup>th</sup> day of September in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred  
3, thirty nine between John Urguhart of the County of Southampton of the one part and Jesse Lowe  
of the said County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said John Urguhart for and in consideration  
of the sum of Sixty six dollars and sixty seven cents of lawful money of this Commonwealth to  
him in hand paid at or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof  
is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto  
the said Jesse Lowe his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying  
and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation forty four acres be the  
same more or less and bounded by the lands of Robert Hart and Benjamin Sampson together  
with all appurtenances belonging or in any wise appertaining to the premises hereby granted  
and the reversions and reversions remainder and remainders and all services benefits and profits  
of said land and premises together with every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights  
claims and interest relating to the same. To have and to hold the said land and other  
premises with every of their rights member and appurtenances unto the said Jesse Lowe  
his heirs and assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoof of him the said Jesse  
Lowe his heirs and assigns forever, and the said John Urguhart doth hereby grant further-  
self and his heirs and every of them will warrant and forever defend the said tract or  
parcel of land and other premises and appurtenances before mentioned and every and particular  
thereof unto the said Jesse Lowe his heirs and assigns forever against himself or any other  
person or persons whatsoever claiming the same or any part or parcel thereof of which right  
and title the said John Urguhart doth hereby warrant and forever defend unto the said Jesse

four swine and six shoats one sideboard and all my household and Kitchen furniture
