This M^l D^r N^o T^h 111st made and entered into this the 12th day of December A.D. 1839 between Thomas B. Jones of the first part Littleton R. Edwards of the second part and Nicholas M. Gibell of the third part. Whereas the said Nicholas M. Gibell has become security of the said Thomas B. Jones to two bonds to Samuel P. Nicholson Commissioner for three hundred and thirty three and one third dollars dated the 12th day of December 1839 one made payable the first day of January 1842 and the other the 1st day of January 1843 and bearing interest from the first day of January 1838 and the said Thomas B. Jones is willing and desirous to secure and indemnify the said Nicholas M. Gibell against all loss and injury from the said security ship. Now this Indenture witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises we will as for the further consideration of the sum of one dollar to him or her paid by the said Littleton R. Edwards the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Thomas B. Jones due by these presents to grant bargains sell and convey unto the said Littleton R. Edwards the following tract or parcels of land situate in the County of Southampton and near the Town of Jerusalem that is to say One tract containing and $\frac{3}{4}$ acres more or less another containing forty six and a half acres more or less and another tract containing twenty one acres more or less being the same land which was conveyed by Samuel P. Nicholson Commissioner of to the said Thomas B. Jones by deed dated the 11th day of December 1839. Together with all the privileges and appurtenances to the said lands in any wise appertaining and belonging. To have and to hold to him the said Littleton R. Edwards his heirs and assigns forever and the said Thomas B. Jones for himself his heirs executors and administrators does covenant with the said Littleton R. Edwards his heirs and assigns that he the said Thomas B. Jones will and his heirs executors and assigns shall warrant and defend the same to the said Littleton R. Edwards his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whatsoever. Upon trust nevertheless that the said Littleton R. Edwards his heirs executors and assigns shall permit the said Thomas B. Jones to remain in quiet and peaceful possession of the said tract or parcels of land and their appurtenances and to take the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said sums of money or either of them or any part of either of them and then upon such further trust that the said Littleton R. Edwards (or in case of his death for his legal personal representative who is hereby authorized to act) shall and will so soon after the happening of such default of payment as he shall be requested by the said Nicholas M. Gibell his executors administrators or assigns so to do sell the said lands and appurtenances or such part thereof as shall be sufficient for the purpose at public auction to the highest bidder for cash after having paid the time and place of sale at his own discretion and given at least thirty days previous notice by advertisement stuck up at the courthouse door of Southampton County and at two or more public places in said County and out of the proceeds of sale shall after satisfying the charges thereof and all other expenses attending the execution of this trust pay to the said Samuel P. Nicholson his executors administrators or assigns the debt aforesaid and the interest thereon or such part thereof as may be due or reimbursed the said Nicholas M. Gibell such sum as he may have been compelled to pay in consequence of said security ship with interest thereon and the balance of any sum over to the said Thomas B. Jones or his executors administrators.
