The Condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Thomas Pringle is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a Commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 29th day of November 1839 If therefore the said Thomas Pringle shall well and truly collect all taxes and pecuniaries and accounts for and pay the same in such manner as is by law directed and also all fines forfeitures and amercements accruing or becoming due to the Commonwealth in the said County and shall duly account for and pay the same to the Treasurer of this Commonwealth for the time being for the use of the Commonwealth in like manner as is or shall be directed in case of public Taxes and shall in all other things truly and faithfully execute the said office of Sheriff during his continuance therein then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and Virtue
