Know all men by these presents that we Thomas Postlow Joseph Postlow Robert Postlow Robert Ricks and Henning Smith are held and firmly bound unto David Campbell Esq Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of Thirty thousand dollars to be paid unto the said Governor and his successors for the use of the Commonwealth for the payment whereof well and truly to be made we bind ourselves and each of us our and each of our heirs executors and administrators jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals unexecuted this 16th day of December 1839.

The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the above bound Thomas Postlow is constituted and appointed Sheriff of the County of Southampton by a commission from the Governor under the seal of the Commonwealth dated the 29th day of November 1839. If therefore the said Thomas Postlow shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the taxes imposed by law and arrears of taxes due in the said County of Southampton and shall truly and faithfully collect account for and pay the militia fines imposed by law and arrears of militia fines due in the said County of Southampton then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue as

This Indenture made this 16th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Thirty nine Between Dorothy Bowe of Temperance his wife of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and Richard Dawson of Southampton of the other part witnesseth that the said Dorothy Bowe & Temperance his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and Twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Richard Dawson the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Dorothy Bowe & Temperance his wife ~~doth~~ ^{have} granted bargained and sold Richard Dawson and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alientate ~~doth~~ ^{have} and confirme unto the said Richard Dawson his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing seventy five acres to the same more or less it being the lot of land which David Newson owned of the land of Benjamin Edwards deceased the right of his wife Lucy. Situated lying and being in the County of Southampton on the south side of Nottoway River and bounded as follows viz Beginning at a new corner made in lot No. 7 being the lot of the children of Isaac Edwards deceased running thence North 86 and East 210 poles to a new corner made in the corner upon the out bounds between David Newson lot No. 5 & George Edwards lot No. 6. thence along the various courses of the out bounds to a point a new corner made in John Morris lot No. 2 now where the crop of corn runs down to the branch thence North 31 West 6 poles to the 1st station to have and to hold the said tract of land and promises and every parcel thereof and also the reversion and reversionary and remainder right title interest claims and demands whatsoever of them the said Dorothy Bowe & Temperance his wife or any other person or persons claiming under them or to the said premises all and singular the said land above mentioned unto the said Richard Dawson for himself and his heirs the said tract of land and every part thereof against themselves and their heirs and against all men
