Witness that the said James Lenow and his wife Elizabeth Lenow for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and seventy dollars to them in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Allen Edwards his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract of plantation or parcel of Land with all the appurtenances thereto belonging containing One hundred and six acres more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton Virginia and known by the name of the Bulls tract being the same land which the said James Lenow purchased of ^{said} Allen Edwards from Bulls and Henry Bulls reference being made to the plat of the boundaries will more fully appear. To have and to hold the said tract of Land to the said Allen Edwards his heirs and assigns forever. And the said James Lenow and Elizabeth Lenow for themselves their heirs & do and will forever warrant and defend against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
