Witnesseth that the said Elizabeth M Woodard and Samuel B Woodard admrs. Jesse Woodard dec^d have bargained granted and sold to by these presents do bargain grant and sell unto Henry Pittway dec^d shares of the tract of land formerly owned by Benjamin Himes dec^d it being their interest in said tract or parcel land for the sum of one hundred and five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Henry Pittway the receipt thereof for the said Elizabeth M Woodard and Samuel B Woodard admrs. of Jesse Woodard dec^d doth hereby acknowledge. To have and to hold the two above named shares or parcels of land with all and singular appurtenances therunto belonging to him and his heirs forever. and the s^d Elizabeth M Woodard and Samuel B Woodard admrs. as aforesaid doth for themselves their heirs execs. and admrs. doth warrant and forever defend the right and title to the s^d Henry Pittway. This Indenture made the day of May 1839 between Wm. Joyner and Mary his wife and Amos Joyner of the one part. and Harrison Joyner of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Wm. Joyner and Mary his wife and Amos Joyner in consideration of the sum of Forty dollars lawful money to them in hand paid by the said Harrison Joyner hath bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Harrison Joyner a certain tract of land lying on the County of Southampton and bounded as follows Beginning at a post oak of Sad Scotts line thence bounded by Scotts line to a red oak corner of Sad Scotts land thence by a line of marked trees to a red oak corner of said line thence by said line to a pine corner at Cross Bowers thence by Bowers line to the first Station Corner turning by estimation Thence goes more or less together with all the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders yearly and other rents issues and profits and every part and parcel thereof. To have and to hold the said tract of land and all and singular other the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold unto the said Harrison Joyner his heirs and assigns forever.
